### ROTARY EDUCATION

*What is the Rotary wheel? The wheel has been the symbol of Rotary since our earliest days. The first design was made in 1905 by a Chicago Rotarian, Montague Bear. The wheel was said to illustrate "Civilization, Movement, and Service work in action." In 1922, it was decided that all Rotary clubs should adopt a single design as the exclusive emblem of Rotarians. So, our present gear wheel, with 24 teeth and six spokes was adopted by Rotary International.*

*The gear teeth around the outside represent the fact that work is to be done. The six spokes represent the inner direction and path of our Vocational Service through our membership. Those same six spokes also represent an outward distribution path of Rotary's ideals of service and the Four Way Test.... going out toward the community.*
