ROTARY EDUCATION

What is the history of the 4-Way Test? It was created by Rotarian Herbert J. Taylor in 1932 when he was asked to take charge of the Chicago Based Club Aluminum Company, which was facing bankruptcy. Taylor looked for a way to save the struggling company mired in

depression-caused financial difficulties. He drew up a 24-word code of ethics for all employees to follow in their business and professional lives. The 4-Way Test became the guide for sales, production, advertising, and all relations with dealers and customers. The survival of Herb's company was credited to this simple philosophy. The 4-Way Test was adopted by Rotary in 1943 and has been translated into more than 100 languages. Herb Taylor became president of Rotary International for 1954-1955 Rotary year.
