ROTARY EDUCATION

- Paul Harris is the founder of Rotary.
- After his death, the response was tremendous with money coming into Rotary for some type of memorial. This was the humble beginning of the Rotary Foundation.
- Now days when a Rotarian gives \$1,000.00 to the Foundation, they become a Paul Harris Fellow. The \$1,000.00 can be paid all at once or over a period of years.
- The Arnold Club has a one Paul Harris roundtable in action. There are three Rotarians in this roundtable. Ron Cool, Al Bishop, Kelli Blevins. They each pay \$125.00/year. When there is a \$1,000.00 paid in, one of the three is awarded the Fellow. These three continue to pay until all three have been awarded a Paul Harris Fellow.
- What happens to the money in the Foundation? It funds worldwide grant projects focusing on health, literacy, and water.
