ROTARY EDUCATION

In addition to overseas projects and local community projects, there are projects in Nebraska, which benefit from Rotary funding. One such project, which was a stop on Nebraska Passport tourism program this summer, is the Whiteclay Makerspace, which is in Whiteclay, Nebraska. This community economic development project, which was awarded a Global Rotary Grant, benefits the Lakota Native Artists and Crafts people who live on or around the Pine Ridge Indian Reservation. The Rotary Foundation has awarded money to this project through Rotarians in India, Australia, Greece, and Mexico, as well as by U.S. Rotarians from South Dakota, Vermont, and Texas. There is a store front as well as workspace. Quilting, beading, leather projects, painting, and jewelry are all on display and some for sale. What is a global grant? This grant supports large international activities with sustainable, measurable outcomes in Rotary's areas of focus.
